# ROCKY GUTTER WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA

(Middleboro/Carver)

GENERAL: 3,005 acres. This area is nearly level with many swampy areas. Old logging trails wind through most of the area.  
U.S.G.S. Quad: Assawompset Pond

VEGETATION: White pine, red maple, oak, black gum, holly and white cedar are common trees. Blueberries and greenbrier are also common.

WATER: Several small streams flow through this area. Rocky Meadow Brook forms part of the northeastern boundary. Double Brook Pond, roughly five acres in size and located on France Street, is heavily choked with shrubs and sphagnum moss.

WILDLIFE: This area is not stocked, and contains only native game such as deer, fox, coyote, rabbit, squirrel and grouse. Numerous nongame species are also present.
