Dear Senate President Rosenberg and Speaker DeLeo:

We write to you today to respectfully request your support for an override of the Governor's veto of funding for the Buzzard's Bay Coalition's water quality monitoring program, the Baywatchers program.

The Baywatchers has received funding through the budget process by the General Court in 1999. The program is the largest coastal monitoring effort in Massachusetts covering the Bay's 30 major harbors and coves in ten municipalities from Westport to Falmouth and works with seventeen cities and towns on water pollution and fishery restoration. The \$125,000 funding provided by the Commonwealth for the Baywatchers program will help leverage more than \$500,000 in federal funds by providing a match for the National Estuary Program funding.

Section 2 in Line 2200-0100 of the FY17 State Budget passed by the General Court identified \$125,000 for coastal water quality monitoring in Buzzards Bay and Vineyard sound. Specifically, the language states, "...\$125,000 shall be expended for the Buzzards Bay Coalition for the coastal water quality monitoring in Buzzards Bay and Vineyard Sound."

We thank you for your consideration and continued support for this program and your efforts to support water quality testing and monitoring.
